## **Workers Comp money illegally donated, received by Governor, 200+ legislators**

A complaint was filed today with the Lt Governor's office showing evidence that thousands of dollars have been inappropriately donated to the campaigns of hundreds of Utah officials, including Governor Herbert from the Utah Workers Compensation Fund (WCF) over the past 16 years.

Steve Maxfield, running mate of Farley Anderson, Independent gubernatorial candidates, claims that both federal and state law prohibit the WCF from participating in politics.

“There are only two appropriate purposes for funds managed by WCF,” Maxfield states. “One is to reimburse its members for losses under the rules of the WCF. The other is expenses to administer the fund. Campaign contributions and funding activities, such as bowling, for elected officials is way outside their scope.”

“Campaign contributions from the WCF are unethical, immoral and possibly illegal,” stated Anderson. “Padding campaigns with money employers have trusted to the WCF to care for their workers is just plain wrong.”
